What to look out for when planning a wardrobe

Determine your personal requirements

The first step is to measure the room precisely. Not only should the width, height and depth of the available space be taken into account, but also elements such as radiators or light switches. At TEAM 7, the development of a wardrobe is based precisely on the architectural conditions. Every detail of the room, be it floors, niches, corners or slopes, is incorporated into the design with millimetre precision.

The next step is to determine your personal requirements. For example, if you have a lot of shirts or dresses, you will need enough clothes rails. For T-shirts, jumpers or trousers, on the other hand, open compartments or drawers are ideal. This also determines the required wardrobe depth: As a rule, a wardrobe should be at least 60 cm deep to provide enough space for hangers. The width, in turn, depends on the space available and the number of people using the wardrobe. For easy access, a width of at least 90 cm per person is recommended.

Intelligent use of storage space

Particular attention should be paid to the interior layout. The better the wardrobe is customised to your lifestyle, the more efficiently it makes everyday life easier. Systematic organisation with height-adjustable shelves and clothes rails as well as drawers guarantees the necessary clarity. TEAM 7 wardrobes offer a range of special



features: handleless drawers with touch function or energy-saving LED lighting make them easier to use. Sophisticated organisation systems with shirt pullers or trouser pull-outs also allow intelligent use of storage space. An integrated writing surface with cable apertures can even turn the wardrobe into a fully functional home office. Last but not least, the choice of doors needs to be carefully considered when designing a wardrobe: sliding doors save space and impress with their minimalist look, while hinged doors require a little more space when opening, but allow a perfect overview and expressive designs.
