TEAM 7 therefore finishes the processed wood exclusively with natural oil. In this way, the surfaces remain breathable, absorb moisture and release it again when the air is dry. This creates a noticeably pleasant, healthy room climate, which not least creates a cosy atmosphere.

Long service life

Even the traces of years of use - such as dents or scratches - can be removed with little effort. By avoiding chemical treatments, the wood also remains free of harmful substances and can therefore be fully returned to the material cycle at the end of its long service life.

Customised products

At TEAM 7, every kitchen is planned and customised precisely according to personal wishes and requirements - whether it's a simple kitchen unit or a complete kitchen-living room with kitchen island. A wide variety of aesthetic ideas can be realised in equal measure: they range from an emphatically homely country house style to a modern, clear and minimalist kitchen design. Flexible height, width and depth reductions enable millimetre-precise adjustments, and even customised designs can be implemented - for maximum ergonomics and convenience.

Woods with personality

In addition, different types of wood characterise the personality of every kitchen. TEAM 7 provides a large selection of woods for this purpose: it includes alder and alder white oil, beech, beech heartwood, oak and wild oak as well as oak white oil and wild oak white oil, cherry, walnut and wild walnut. This provides a wide range of creative possibilities for kitchen design: light-coloured woods in combination with white design elements, for example, make kitchens appear larger, while dark wood with black surfaces creates a sophisticated, elegant look.



Harmonious combinations

The materials that are combined with the wood also make a decisive contribution to the character of a solid wood kitchen, for example when choosing the worktop. Here, natural materials such as ceramic, natural stone or coloured glass are particularly suitable for achieving a harmonious spatial effect on the one hand and ensuring qualities such as scratch resistance, impact resistance or heat resistance on the other. The new MDi surfaces, which TEAM 7 is offering for the first time, are proving to be similarly effective. Thanks to a unique manufacturing process, they are visually appealing, hard-wearing and environmentally friendly in equal measure. MDi consists of half recycled materials and uses hardly any water during production, which reduces emissions by 90 per cent compared to industry standards and therefore helps to protect the climate.

Consistent climate protection

Speaking of the climate: TEAM 7 only uses wood from sustainable forestry for its kitchens. This ensures that the forests, which are so important for climate protection, are preserved for future generations. Furniture of the highest quality is created from this renewable raw material with great attention to detail. The production in Austria and the complete control of the value chain guarantee environmentally conscious, sustainable manufacturing.
